Course Description and Goals: The pre-doctoral internship is a full calendar year (or two years, half-time) supervised training experience in an approved clinical setting. The internship will include intensive exposure to various professional issues, the opportunity to work with a diverse range of clinical populations and problems, and advanced training in the use of specific psychological assessment and intervention strategies.

Evaluation: This internship will be evaluated on a Credit/Fail basis, based upon the recommendation of the internship staff. In order to facilitate discussion, or to deal with performance that may lead to a recommended failure, an interim evaluation of the student is expected. The internship is a pre-doctoral requirement which must be satisfactorily completed before a student will be authorized to receive a doctoral degree.

The last day to drop this course and **still receive a tuition fee refund** is **Sep 23, 2011**. Last day for registration/change of registration is **Sep 26**th, **2011**. The last day to withdraw from this course is **Apr 13, 2012**.
